



Make your own binoculars!

You will need:

- X2 cardboard tube from either a kitchen roll or loo roll
- Scissors
- Sellotape
- Coloured card or paint/colouring pens or pencils
- String





Step 1



- Decorate the cardboard tubes with either coloured paper, paint or colouring pens/pencils (we decided to print out a camouflage pattern!)



Step 2



- Cut out two strips of card to put around one end of your binoculars



Step 3



- Use a small piece of card to fix the binoculars together



Step 4



- Make a hole on the outer side of each cardboard tube (remember to ask an adult if you need help!)
- You can then thread your string through the holes to make a strap



What can you spot through your binoculars?



- A bird
- A flower
- A tree
- A cloud
- A car
